




Poster of Tired Leah and its development 1




I also wanted to deliver that Leah was actually a part of nature originally as a human being.

Description: I wanted to experiment various styles of Leah for cover page, but both drawings are Leah's image after she decides to become a part of nature.









Description: My theme for the Cambridge final art exam was folding and pleating, so I folded each paper of a book, and turn it into a figure of flower.


